RE: INSURANCE COMPANIES ACROSS ALL LINES OF COVERAGE – NO
CANCELLATIONS FOR FAILURE TO PAY IN AFFECTED AREAS

On April 23, 2026, the Insurance Commissioner issued Directive 26-EX-1. The Directive precluded companies from cancelling insurance policies in specified affected counties until a Directive from the Insurance Commissioner lifted such prohibition. On May 8, 2026, the Insurance Commissioner issued Directive 26-EX-3 lifting the previous directive for certain areas of the state.

As a result of recovery efforts, the restrictions which were imposed by Directive 26-EX-3 will be lifted on May 27, 2026.
